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# Restaurant captures prestigious accolade

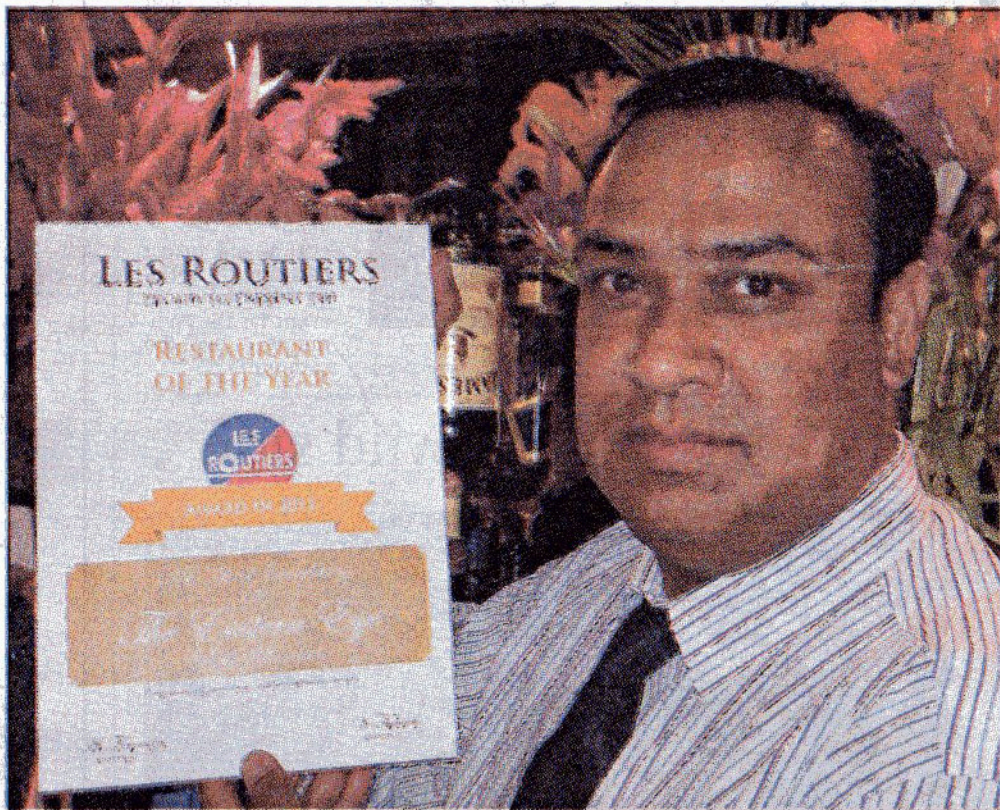
An Indian restaurant has proved it is hot stuff by winning a Les Routiers award.
